About Gary Jobson: Gary is a former All-American collegiate sailor. He won the America's Cup in 1977 as tactician for Ted Turner. As a broadcaster/producer (he is ESPN's Sailing Analyst), lecturer, and writer (he is an Editor at Large for Sailing World and Cruising World magazines), Jobson is the pre-eminent ambassador for sailing in the U.S.

Gary has won many championships in one design classes, the Americas Cup in 1977, the infamous Fastnet Race and many of the world's ocean races. In college he was an All-American sailor three times and was twice named College Sailor of the Year (1972, 1973). In October 2003 Gary was inducted into the America's Cup Hall of Fame by the Herreshoff Marine Museum. Over the past 25 years Gary has given nearly 2500 lectures through out the world. He started his career as a sailing coach at the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy and the U.S. Naval Academy.
